NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 National prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for Rule 42*, will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to all participants between 12 – 18 years old (2017).
- 2.2 All competitors are required to have at least Dinghy Proficiency Level 1 for single-handed dinghy sailors.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee by 30 June 2017 to:

- 8 THE COURSES**
The diagrams in Attachment 3 show the courses, including the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.
- 9 PENALTY SYSTEM**
Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.
- 10 SCORING**
1 race is required to be completed to constitute an event.
- 11 SUPPORT BOATS**
Support boats shall be identified with respective national letters displayed on the engine covers.
- 12 BERTHING**
Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.
- 13 RADIO COMMUNICATION**
Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**
Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 15 INSURANCE**
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
