



TABLE TENNIS COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

(Updated on 18 April 2016)

1. Date & Venue

The competition will be held from 18th-21st June 2016 at:

Singapore 569777

2. General Rules

- 2.1 The competition shall be run in accordance with the latest rules and regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF). Rules and regulations of the ITTF can be downloaded from www.ittf.com.
- 2.2 40+mm white or orange balls shall be used during the competition.
- 2.3 No white apparels (shirt and shorts) are allowed. Players who fail to conform shall be disqualified.
- 2.4 All players are requested to produce their Identity Card/Student Pass for verification during their registration.
- 2.5 The Organising Committee reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the competition at any time without prior notification. Any other rules that are not covered by the Rules and Regulations will be decided by the Organising Committee, whose decision will be FINAL.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 This competition is open to all Singaporean and PR only.
- 3.2 All participant must be ages 17 and below.
 - Under 14 - Born on or after 1 Jan 2002
 - Under 17 – Born on or after 1 Jan 1999

4.3 Registration by e-mail, telephone and fax will NOT be accepted.

4.4 Late, unclear and incomplete forms will NOT be accepted.

4.5 No refund of registration fee will be entertained.

4.6 All team members have to submit the declaration form together with the registration form. Registration is on a first come, first served basis.

4.7 The closing date for registration is Sat 04th June 2016 at 5.00 pm.

4.8 Any event with less than EIGHT (8) entries will be scratched. However, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to organize the event if there is a short of entries. If the event is scratched, registration fees will be refunded.

4.9 Registration Fees: \$30.00 per team per event.

5. Tournament System

The order of play would be:

- 1st single
- Doubles
- 2nd single

- 5.1 No repetition of player is allowed.
- 5.2 A minimum of 4 and maximum of 7 players are allowed in each team over the course of whole competition.
- 5.3 All events will be play on a round robin system followed by a single knockout system.
- 5.4 The preliminary round will be played to the best-of-5 games (11 points).
- 5.5 All semi-finals and finals will be played to the best-of-5 games (11 points).
- 5.6 There will be play-off for 3rd placing
- 5.7 Non-reporting of 15 minutes will consider a walkover.

6. Draws and Fixtures

- 6.1 An open draw of competition fixtures will be conducted on Saturday, at 6.30pm, 11th June 2016 at Yio Chu Kang Sports Hall, 210 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 9, Singapore 569777. All are welcome to witness the draw.
- 6.2 No Seeding of team will be awarded to teams for this competition.
- 6.3 Fixtures will be displayed on 13th June 2016 at 12.00 pm and will be posted on website: www.syof.sg.
- 6.4 Any discrepancy or omission of entries must be brought up to the attention of Organising Committee within the 1st day of competition.
- 6.5 Draws for 2nd round will be conducted immediately after the Qualify Round & display on the noticeboard at the venue.

7. Final and Prize Presentation

- 7.1 Final and the Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held immediately after the finals of the events.
- 7.2 All prize winner MUST be present at the ceremony in neat attire (no singlet, slippers and sandals) in order to receive the prize.

- 7.3 All prize winners MUST be present in person, in order to receive the medals. No representatives are allowed.
- 7.4 If prize winners do not turn up during the prize presentation ceremony, medals will not be awarded.
- 7.5 Prize vouchers will only be awarded to the first, second and third positions.
